Information sheet for students enquiring about the Eurythmy Training

APPLICATIONS

A new course is admitted in early September every two years. The next intake will be in September 2010. It is advisable to apply as soon as possible. Each applicant should complete the application form, attach the required documents and pass on the medical form to their doctor for completion.

It is strongly recommended that prospective students have some experience of community life or social therapy before they start the eurythmy training. One or other of the Camphill Communities can offer this experience.

The first year of the training is considered as a trial after which suitability to continue into the second year will be assessed.

SCHOOL FEES

The school fees will be @ £645 for the first year starting in September 2010, plus board and lodging @£3620. Details of the fees for the other years of the training can be obtained from the Eurythmy School.

Fees are paid termly and are due at the beginning of each term. If a student stops his or her studies during a term, the fees for that term will not necessarily be refunded.

The Eurythmy School can give advice and information regarding loans, although they are not usually available for a first year.
